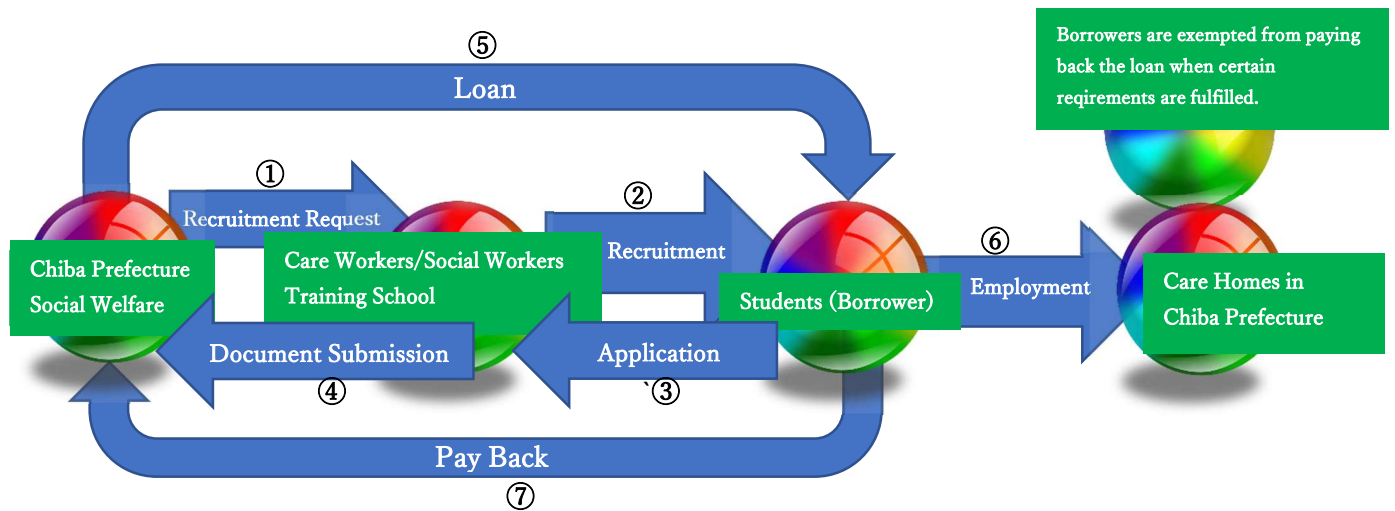

Care Workers/Social Workers Training School Loan System

Flow Chart of the Loan System



How much is, and what is the breakdown of the loan?

- Monthly payment equivalent to the tuition fee per month: up to ¥50,000 (monthly)
- Preparation fee for entering school: ¥200,000 (one time only, first payment)
- Preparation fee for starting job ¥200,000 (one time only, last payment)
- Preparation fee for National Exam for Certified Care Workers: up to ¥40,000 (maximum of 2 years)
- ※ Living expenses may be added in if needed if you are deemed to be in a welfare household or similar economic situation.

Who can apply for the loan?

Persons who entered a care worker or social worker training facility (of university, college or vocational school) which is appointed both by the Minister of Social Welfare and Labor and the Governor of Chiba Prefecture, and who has a will to be engaged in working for welfare facilities such as care homes in Chiba as a Certified Care Worker or a Certified Social Worker after graduation.

※ This loan system cannot be used with other loans and benefits depending on national expenses such as living welfare fund mother and child support funds, father and son support funds, widow welfare funds, or vocational training payments. (the educational training benefit system has become acceptable to be used in combination with the loan from the 2020 application).

What are the requirements to be exempt from paying back the loan?

All of the loan will be forgiven if you meet all 5 of the requirements below.

- ① You registered as a Certified Care Worker or a Certified Social Worker
- ② are engaged in a care work job or consultation support,
- ③ within a year after the graduation of the Care Worker Training School,
- ④ in Chiba Prefecture, and

⑤ *kept working for at least 5 years.*

※ You will have to pay back the loan if you drop out of the training school and/or you quit the care work or consultation job, including if you never got a job of those at any of these places.

How to apply

The training facilities (University, College or Vocational school) will take care of all the application documents on behalf of the new students after their entrance. A recommendation form from the school should be attached.

※ A **joint guarantor** will be required to apply.
